Some discussion on pinwheels: Need discussion on outcomes. DOH want outcomes. PCAH worked with Girl Scouts of Hawaii on Oahu - putting pinwheels in and developing badge for them...Maui Girl Scouts can do that too...bank and grocery stores...getting a patch for doing this...outcome for it...somehow document outcomes, some kind of foundation of why you're doing it as held accountable for all of this stuff. Reports from us ->PCAH goes to DOH ->DOH goes to Governor's office ->Governor's office sends to Feds...report, document, show, tell...there's a broader audience now, still in development and work as a Team...Paul is good at getting media there...Molokai and Lanai has pinwheels..write-ups so important this year...federal grant putting together right now..deadline middle of May (get info to her by May)...Aileen finding out about logo for HCF to include in flyer...Bob putting on HCTF hat and wants to make PF training a model for state training...idea from HCF...discuss at April training...Paul will take lead..just discussion, no decision...coalition meeting statewide...willing to look at...HCTF hat – grants written up, meeting yest w/HCF, board and PCAH officers for trust fund, looking at idea of paid coordinator positions and looking to Ho'oikaika as model with paid part-time coordinator position...write-up from 3 years ago...how position made it work...show growth from coordination position, put as agenda at Core meeting in April...this goes to HCTF, not HCF...Maui has become foundation for statewide paid position model. Brags about Maui all the time...Edel presenting to HCF on April 7.....status of PF books from Karen, available for April CAN? Call 1-800 Parent Line...October conference – Tina wants brochure...Fans, crayons bags chip clips - Kaina question..extras to go to Keiki Fest.5000 kids attend Keiki Fest..FCJC does spin the weel...Paul does track info...Bob will check inventory by Monday...Molokai needs items....Paul will be contact/point person for Molokai...Ka'ina question: did you get info on 4/1 Sexual Violence...who should Ka'ina send it to...send to Amanda at Imua.

March 5<sup>th</sup> HYAEC conference update from Tina and Ka'ina. Jeny and Tina spoke with Dr. Kimo Alameda and he is confirmed for October PF Conference. Karen gave us a shout out as speaker. "How it impacts you?" Karen got their attention...why do I care? Passed out adult and keiki brochures. He put it in phone calendar. Present PF, listen to youth speaker and tie it together...he's excited, doing cultural and taking it to community. Next Core meeting agenda topic Dr. Alameda. County supported 28 scholarships ECE and

7 travel ones. No one from Hana. Lanai declined scholarships. About 230 registered attendees on Thursday.

Lanai Proclamation co-hosted by Lanai DV Task Force. Connie Meekhof from PACT will read proclamation. Proclamation will be either Tuesday, April 5 or Wednesday, April 6. Outcomes. Uncle Wayne performance justified outcome as lots of Maui events occurred last year. Too late and was not in budget for Uncle Wayne to perform in Lanai this year. Combined event, Young Child and Keiki Fest. Connie will discuss with Beverly Zigmond and Bev will get in touch with Ashley so we can help create Lanai flyer for them.

Update from Ka'ina on inviting preschoolers to Mayor's Proclamation. 250 may be unrealistic from Ka'ina. Uncle Wayne will be performing concert at St. Anthony before Mayor's Proclamation so some of the preschoolers attending there will not be in attendance at event....Wailuku Elem preschool...area preschools to invite, one preschool boycotted Mayor's Proclamation and will not attend event. Invited head start (20 people) Wailuku Union (no answer yet, 30 kids) Punaleo (sp?) (40 children) Iao Preschool (40 kids attending) Infant/toddler Little Explorers ...Honwanji...Tutu and Me...Keiki O'Kaina....Malama....mass flyer list...Ashley told Ka'ina she brought daughter to Chinese New Year's Celebration in Feb at County Building Front Lawn and saw Wailuku and Kahului Honwanji kids there and asked Ka'ina to possibly invite the same preschoolers who attended in Feb to April event...email Paul...Judge Tanaka speaking or not? Ka'ina will give us update by Fri March 18.

Finalize planning for April CAN events. Whole Foods is donating 250 protein snack bars and Ashley will pick-up. Ka'ina asked for ingredients of snack bars as can't have peanuts. Adults can eat the snack bars, does not need to be for kids. Finalize inventory to include in goodie bags. Any volunteers to take photos at event? Karen volunteered and will bring big camera.
